You are cordially invited to attend this ceremony and you can be accompanied by 2 or 3 other people. A programme for your visit will be scheduled, which includes an official lunch.



We would also inform you that we have an exhibition (and leaflets) about the Europe Prize available for you upon request, which comprises seven panels (six panels measuring 80/200 cm and one measuring 150/200 cm). The exhibition was created to mark the 60th anniversary of the Europe Prize and is available in nine languages (English, French, German, Italian, Polish, Russian, Spanish, Turkish and Ukrainian). It is a travelling exhibition which moves from town to town: each town which books the exhibition then sends it on to the next town. Please contact the Secretariat if you wish to host the exhibition (for a period of three weeks to a month).
